# ON TURNING TO ALLĀH TO REMOVE THE CORONAVIRUS<sub>1</sub>

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*In the Name of Allāh, the Most Beneficent, Most Merciful*

*All praise is due to Allāh, the Lord of the Worlds, and may prayers and peace be upon our Prophet Muhammad, his family and all of his companions.*

This is a reminder of what the Muslims are going through these days, rather what the world is going through, with the pandemic, or hidden disease, this virus known as 'corona' in which many of creation have died and threatens the rest of the people. It is obligatory on the Muslims especially, and on the world generally, to turn to Allāh, Glory Unto Him, to avert this danger and remove it. As Allāh is the One who descended this and He is Ever-Able to remove it and grant prevention from it to the Muslims. Allāh Says,

**“And when adversity touches you at sea, lost are [all] those you invoke except for Him.”**

There is no way to turn, no safety and no rescue from this danger or anything else except by turning to Allāh, Mighty and Majestic. Placing oneself before Allāh, making much supplication for Allāh to remove it and suffice the Muslims from its evil, rather for the whole world to be sufficed from its danger. As Allāh is the one who descended it and He is Ever-Able to remove it, Glory unto Him, and that for Allāh is easy. However, it is upon us to be reminded of our weakness and our need for Allāh, Glory unto Him, and that we increase our supplication, charity, good actions, as maybe Allāh will remove that which He has descended. As He is Ever-Capable over all things.

It is obligatory on the Muslims specifically, and the world generally, to turn to Allāh to remove this darkness and to have prevention from it. Allāh is Ever-Able to do that. For this reason, increased supplication, increased goodness to the poor and needy by giving charity, and doing good actions, as Allāh is Ever-Near and the Most-Responsive. Allāh Says,

**“And when My servants ask you [O Muhammad], concerning Me – indeed I am near. I respond to the invocation of the supplicant when he calls upon Me. So let them respond to Me [by obedience] and believe in Me that they may be [rightly] guided.”**
